Botanical Name : *Vernonia anthelmintica* Willd.

Family : Asteraceae

Introduction : Seed very much useful in intestinal worm infections.

English : Purple Flea-bane, Achenes

Morphology :

Annual herb, grows 40-60 cm height

Leaves- simple, alternate, hairy , serrate, lanceolate

Flower-purple,

Fruit – achenes

Distribution &Habitat : All over India, waste lands

Chemical constituents :

Delta-7-avenasterol, Centratherin and germacranolide

Properties :

RASA- kashya, tikta GUNA-laghu

VIRYA- ushna (according to dhanatharinigandu – sita)

VIPAKA-katu

Karma : mutralam, deepana,netryam, stamba

Anthelmintic, stomachic, diuretic, anti inflammatory, anodyne, purgative,

Indication :

Kushta, kandu, sopha, gulma, krimi, swasa, kasa, vrana

Skin disease, asthma, cough, leprosy, leucoderma, colic, fever, worms

Part used : Fruits

Dosage : Leaf juice 10-15 ml Powder 2-4 g

Decoction 50-100 ml

Therapeutic Uses :- Fruit paste in resin of papaya along with honey useful in intestinal worms.
