Hedychium - Hedys Sweet, Chion Snow Sweet scented snow, flowers are fragrant
spicatum-Spiked

Family - Zingiberaceae

Habitat - Sari is cultivated throughout India.

Morphology -

Habit: Herbaceous plant with underground stem.

Leaves → More than 30 cm long, oblong or oblong- lanceolate, variable in breadth. It is glabrous.

long Inflorescence → Dense flowered spike, up to 30 cm

Bracts: Large, oblong, green, 2.5 to 4 cm long and 2 cm wide: 1 flowered.

Flowers White, cuneate lip and deeply bifid.

Fruits Capsule, glabrous and globose.

Part used:Kanda (Rhizome)

Chemical Constituents -

Rhizome contains 4% of volatile oil. 52% of starch. Volatile oil contains paramethoxy cinnamic acid, Cineole limonene, Ethyl cinnamate, Hedychenone, 7-hydroxybedychnone, Methylparacumarin, Limonene, b-Phellandrene, bterpineol and Cinnamic ethyl acetate.

Doṣakarma (Action on Doṣa) - Vatakaphaśāmaka. Vatahara because of Uṣṇavīrya. Kapha śāmaka due to Usnavīrya, Kaṭuvipāka and Kaṭutikta, Kaṣaya rasa.

Karma (Actions) -

Sidhmahara. Śwāsaḥara, Kāsaḥara, Hikkānigrahaṇa, Sothaḥara, Vranahara, Śūlaḥara,

Pharmacological Actions -

Antihypertensive, Antispasmodic, Expectorant, Anthelmintic, Febrifuge, Stimulant, Stomachic, Carminative, Anti-inflammatory and Emmanagogue.

AmayikaPrayoga (Therapeutic administration)

1. Arśas (Piles)

In case of Arsas (Piles) one has to take the gruel prepared from Śati (Hedychium spicatum) and Palāśa (Butea monosperma) seed mixed with sour buttermilk and blackpepper.

2. Amavāta (Rhumatoid Arthritis)

In Āmavāta (Rhumatiod arthritis) patient should take a paste of Safi (Hedychium spicatum) and Viswausadha (Zingiber officinale) with decoction of Punamana (Boerhaviadiffusa).

Matra (Dose):Curna (Powder) - 3 to 6 g
